Remember Your Baptism – Look at pictures from your baptism day or hear stories from folks who remember. Take the advice of Martin Luther, keep a bowl of water by the front door and before you leave dip your finger in water and make the sign of the cross on your hand or forehead and look in a mirror and say “I am baptized!” Remembering that you belong to God and that nothing can separate you from God’s love is a great way to start the day!

Grieve & Apologize – Say you are sorry – learning to apologize when we have made a mistake is a great spiritual practice. We all need to repent and to turn from our old ways and live as new creations in Christ. Send a note of apology and have a courageous conversation with someone you have wronged.

Share a link from or tell someone about FPCRW – There are exciting things going on in the life of FPCRW. Share a link from the church (facebook.com/FPCRW) or tell someone about something happening at church that you are excited about.

Re-write a creed or hymn with expansive language – There are so many names for God! Read this article (<http://queergrace.com/language-in-worship/>) and use it to inspire you to re-write a creed or hymn you know with expansive language.

Try Lectio Divina with the Book of James – This is an ancient way to pray the Scripture. Pick a passage of James and use this guide (<https://www.conceptionabbey.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/11/lectio-divina-card.pdf>) to listen to what God has for you in the Scripture today.

Find out whose ancestral land you live on – Type in your address to this website (<https://native-land.ca/>) and learn about the nations to whom this land belonged. Follow the links to learn more.

Visit and Learn about a local Indigenous Sacred Site - Visit a local site like He Mni Can (Barn Bluff), the Prairie Island Indian Community, or visit the Explore Minnesota website for other locations (<https://www.exploreminnesota.com/article/museums-historic-sites-share-american-indian-cultures>)

Send a note to a graduate – We have one high school graduate and 3 college graduates this year to celebrate. Call or email the church office and we will get you the address of one of our graduates so that you can send them a note of congratulations.
